

Below are a couple of things you can do that may help with the problem. Internet Explorer 8 has a **Compatibility View** that will allow you to view websites that are not IE8 compatible. It displays in an IE7 environment. Below are the directions to operate this function. Also, if you would prefer to uninstall IE8, I have provided you with the directions below.

## Enhanced navigation

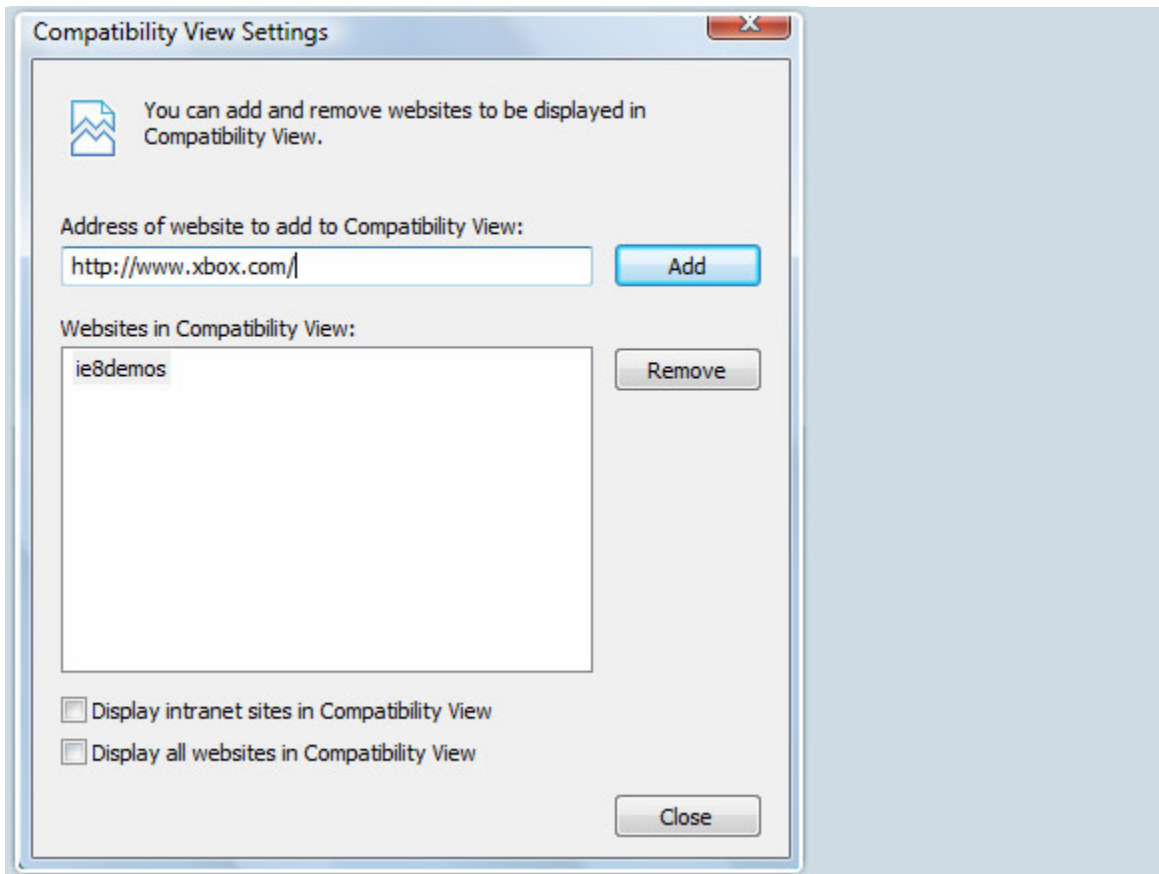
### Compatibility View

Internet Explorer 8 is a new release and some websites may not yet be ready for Internet Explorer 8. Click the **Compatibility View** toolbar button to display the website as viewed in Internet Explorer 7, which will correct display problems like misaligned text, images, or text boxes. This option is on a per site basis and all other sites will continue to display with Internet Explorer 8 functionality. To go back to browsing with Internet Explorer 8 functionality on that site, simply click the **Compatibility View** button again.



Try clicking the "Compatibility View" toolbar button to fix the problem. It's located next to the Refresh button on the Address Bar.

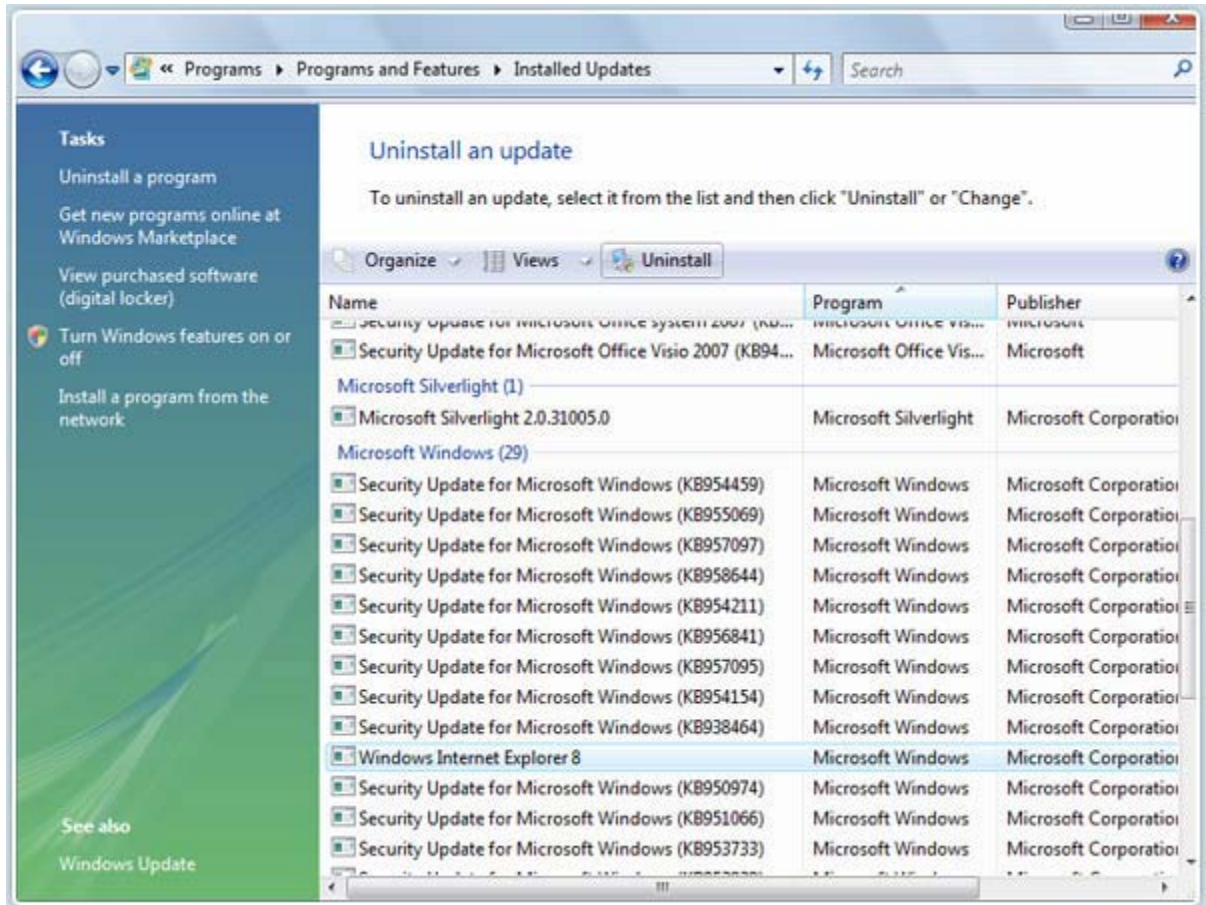
You can maintain a list within Internet Explorer 8 for sites that should be displayed in Compatibility View. From the **Command Bar**, select **Tools**, and then select **Compatibility View Settings** to add and remove sites from this list. There are also options for viewing all websites and intranet sites in Compatibility View.



### [How do I uninstall Internet Explorer 8?](#)

For Windows Vista users:

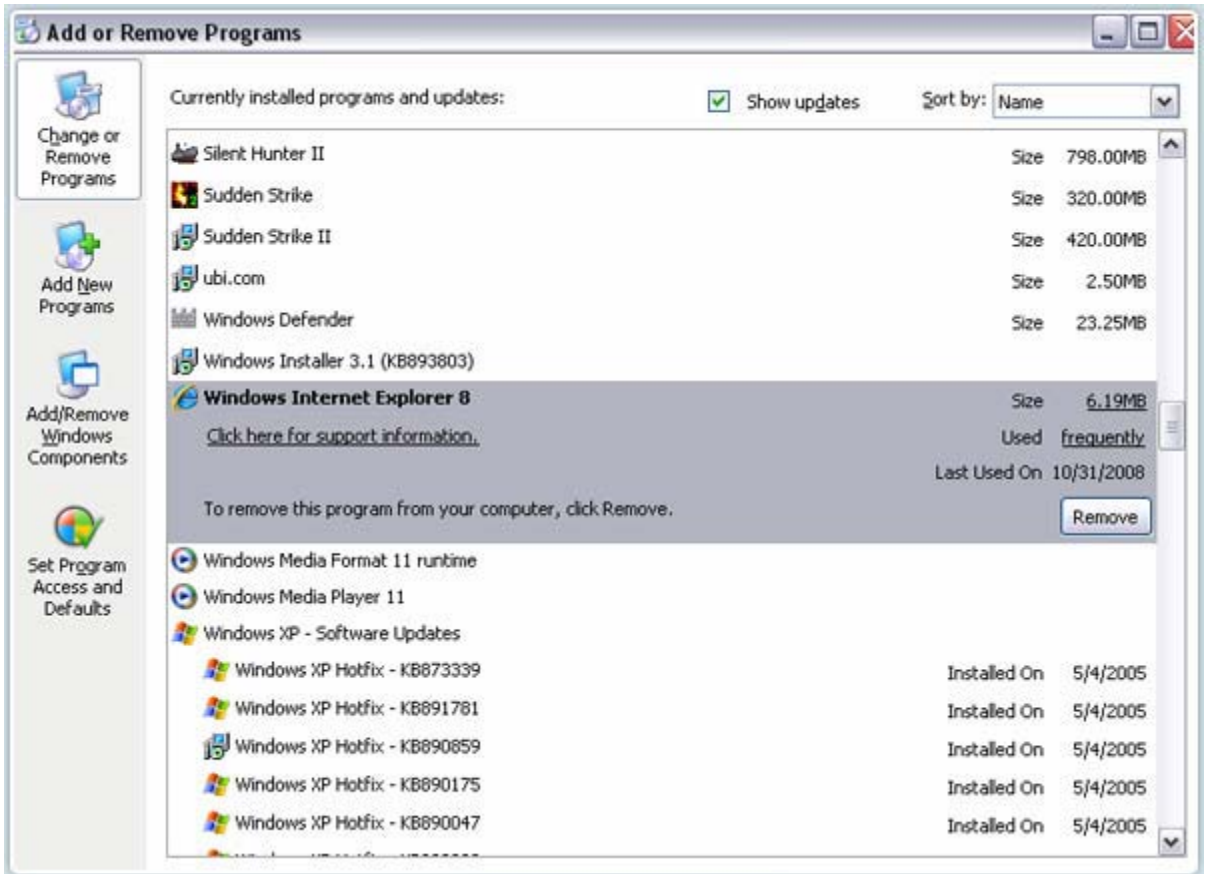
1. Click **Start**, and then click **Control Panel**.
2. In the upper-left of the window, make sure you click on **Control Panel Home** so that Classic View is not active.
3. Click **Uninstall a program** from the lower-left of the window, OR from under the program section.
4. Click **View installed updates** from the upper-left of the window.
5. Wait a few seconds for all your updates to appear on the list, then scroll down the listing and highlight Windows Internet Explorer 8.



6. Click **Uninstall** from the top of the window to remove Internet Explorer 8.

For Windows XP Users:

1. Click **Start**, and then click **Control Panel**.
2. Click **Add or Remove Programs**.
3. Make sure there is a check mark in the **Show updates** box in the upper-middle of the window.
4. Scroll down the list and highlight **Internet Explorer 8**, then click **Remove** to uninstall.
